These conversation starters can help you talk to your doctor at your next appointment. If your doctor is unable to offer you further treatment options, ask for a referral to an epilepsy specialist. - 6. What are the differences between the treatment options available?
- 7. If I am a candidate for an advanced treatment option, what are the next steps?

- 9. What kinds of side effects are associated with the various treatment options?
